

## The Enhanced Lima Work Programme on Gender (LWPG)



### Background

The Enhanced Lima Work Programme on Gender (LWPG) and its Gender Action Plan (GAP) aim to embed gender considerations into global climate policies. They work to ensure balanced representation and empower women as leaders and stakeholders in climate resilience and policy. Objectives and activities are set out under five key priority areas: capacity-building, participation and women's leadership, coherence, gender-responsive implementation, and monitoring.

### State of Play

At COP28 and SB60, progress on gender-responsive climate policies was reviewed under the Enhanced Lima Work Programme on Gender (LWPG) and its Gender Action Plan (GAP). Discussions focused on advancing the five priority areas in the Global Stocktake (GST) and highlighted successes and challenges in implementing gender considerations, particularly by least developed countries (LDCs). With 85% of nations integrating gender into their climate plans, ongoing efforts aim to enhance inclusivity and improve frameworks for supporting gender equality in climate policies. A final review of the LWPG and GAP will occur at COP29.



### Key Questions for COP29

At COP29, the Enhanced Lima Work Programme on Gender (LWPG) and Gender Action Plan (GAP) will be reviewed. Specifically, discussions will seek to address integrating gender in transparency frameworks, particularly within Biennial Transparency Reports (BTRs) to assess gender impacts in climate policies. Events such as Gender Equality Day and Gender in Transparency will explore how to improve accountability, how to remove barriers to women's participation in climate action, and how to strengthen gender-responsive strategies in NDCs and adaptation efforts.
