## WHAT IS COP?

### The UN Annual Climate Change Conference / Conference of Parties

Brings together world leaders, ministers and negotiators to agree on how to address climate change

### Negotiating Parties include:

Governments that have signed:

- The UN Framework Convention on Climate Change
- The Kyoto Protocol (subgroup)
- The Paris Agreement (subgroup)

Representatives from:

- Civil society
- The private sector
- International organisations
- The media



## 3 MAIN GOALS

### RE: PARIS AGREEMENT

1

Keep global average temperature rise to 'well below' 2°C and pursue efforts to limit the rise to 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels

2

Adapt to climate change and build resilience

3

Align finance flows with 'a pathway towards low greenhouse gas emissions and climate-resilient development'.

## BLUE ZONE

Managed by the UNFCCC.  
Critical space for decision-making and negotiations.

*Includes negotiation zones and pavilion zones.\**

- Parties (Country negotiators)
- Observers (NGOs, IGOs, UN Agencies)
- Media
- World Leaders

*\*Requires a badge: only UNFCCC-accredited participants have access.*

## GREEN ZONE

Delivered by the COP host country (Brasil). Hub of collaboration and inspiration to promote public engagement.  
Open to civil society.

*Exhibits, events, activities, booths, and displays.*

- Civil Society
- Private Sector
- NGOs
- Arts & Media

## PAVILIONS

An area in the Blue Zone where Parties or Observer Organisations have their own space.

*Small rooms or booths where they can:*

- Host events
- Showcase research and expertise
- Open informal discussions

## YOUTH SPACE

There will be a Children & Youth Pavilion in the Blue Zone.

*Entirely led by young people, youth-led networks and NGOs.*

- Discussion, education, briefings
- Opportunity for youth to engage directly with world decision-makers and delegates
